A two-fold lacquer screen depicting a persimmon tree in gold, silver and various coloured taka-maki-e (high-relief lacquer) against a dark orange ground

Signed: Seishi saku (made by Seishi)

Japan, Showa era 1942

Dimensions: H. 105 cm x W. 124cm (41<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 48<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>")

The tomobako (original wood box) is signed Ishii Seishi saku (made by Ishii Seishi), sealed Seishi, and inscribed Showa junana nen no Bunten shuppin (exhibited at the Bunten exhibition in 1942).
